What happens next?

A member of staff will contact you to arrange an initial appointment for you to see one of our consultants. Eye drops will be used to dilate patients pupils, therefore patients should not attempt to drive home.

A second appointment will be arranged for you to attend for a Biometry test.

Procedure date

Your surgery date appointment will be sent to you in writing.

On the day of your procedure, you will be admitted on to the ward. The majority of patients have their surgery performed under a local anaesthetic and are discharged home the same day. It is advised that you have someone to stay with you at home the night of the procedure.

Follow up

A follow up appointment will be arranged for you approximately 3/4 weeks after your procedure. If your consultant is happy with your progress, you will be discharged back you your optician.
